



## ST BARTHS ENTRY INFORMATION

Please note the entry requirements depend on countries classification based on French health indicators.

**Please note the entry requirements for the countries listed in GREEN, ORANGE and RED:**

*Green Countries : France and other European countries, United States of America, Australia, Saudi Arabia, Bahrain, South Korea, Israel, Japan, Lebanon, New Zealand, Argentina, Chili, Uruguay, Taiwan, The United Arab Emirates, Hong Kong, Jordan, Kuwait, Qatar, Rwanda, Senegal, Republic of the Comoros, Uruguay, Vanuatu.*

*Orange countries: UK, Canada, Mexico... and all countries, except "green" and "red" countries.*

*Red countries: Afghanistan, Brazil, Costa-Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Moldavia, Pakistan, Russia, Montenegro, Serbia, Suriname, Turkey.*

St Barths welcomes travellers coming from **GREEN, ORANGE and RED** Countries presenting a **proof of vaccination** (e.g. CDC vaccination card or QR code), and a negative PCR or negative antigen test within **48 hours** taken before departure.

### **EXCEPTION FOR US CITIZENS:**

**Vaccinated travelers: No test is required to enter St Barths for all US citizens coming from United States of America presenting a proof of vaccination.**

**Unvaccinated travelers aged 12 or older must present a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours or an antigen test taken within 48 hours of the departure flight to St. Barths to be approved entry.**

## TRANSIT INFORMATION

### SXM - Juliana airport, St Marteen\*

**All passengers arriving / departing** by air, boat or in transit, are required to fill **the Saint-Maarten EHAS form** for pre-approval. You will find the application by clicking [here](#). **Please note this form also needs to be completed for your departure, and you will need to check the entry details of your return country.** Information available [here](#).

All non-fully vaccinated children 5 year of age and older are required to have a negative PCR test taken within 48 hours or a negative antigen test taken within 24 hours before departure.

\*Please note that the country classification for St Marteen is different from that established by the French government.

\*Entry requirements for all passengers in transit to St Marteen on their way to St Barths.

**St Martin French side** - Entry requirements are the same in the French part of St Martin as in St Barths. If traveling with the *Voyager ferry*, kindly please check their travel requirements [here](#).

**PTP - Pointe à Pitre, Guadeloupe** - Official Guadeloupe travel information available [here](#).

A negative PCR test or a negative antigen test taken within 96 hours before departure is requested.

**Puerto Rico** - Travelers entering Puerto Rico must fill out a Travel Declaration Form through the Puerto Rico Health Department's online portal, Information available [here](#) .

**Private aviation** - The entry requirements remain the same for all visitors. **Please be reminded that you should always specify your destination when arranging private flights.** Kindly check with the local FBO for further details.

## TEST REQUIREMENTS

A COVID-19 test must be taken by an accredited laboratory in the host country.

At home COVID-19 testing solutions [including live testing support from certified guides](#) are also accepted.

## VACCIN & INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS

France accepts vaccines recognized by the European Drug Agency (EMA): Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson & Johnson and Covishield.

## CHILDREN

Children under the age of 12 do not require proof of a COVID-19 testing to enter St Barths. Children aged between 12 and under the age of 18 must provide a negative COVID-19 test to enter St Barths (except for US citizens coming from United States of America).

**Attention:** Guests with children over the age of 5 do require a negative COVID-19 test if transiting via St Marteen (except for US citizens coming from United States of America).

## INSURANCE

**We strongly recommend that guests acquire travel insurance aimed to cover flight delays, flight cancellations, mandatory quarantine, medical evacuation, or inability to travel due to a positive COVID-19 test result.**
